Market awareness campaign with barricades and mask distribution during the COVID-19 pandemic involved a multi-faceted approach aimed at ensuring public safety and Arranged for the procurement of masks, barricades, and other necessary materials. Ensured that sufficient quantities were available to cover the target areas

Covid – Free Mask Distribution



MASK-DISTRIBUTION



The distribution of free masks during the COVID-19 pandemic was a crucial public health intervention aimed at curbing the spread of the virus. Our Mask distribution complemented other public health measures such as social distancing and hand hygiene, creating a comprehensive approach to controlling the spread of the virus. Our free mask distribution initiative was instrumental in enhancing public health safety, increasing accessibility to protective equipment, and encouraging compliance with mask-wearing guidelines.

Covid- Free Clinic in North Chennai



The free clinic has visited by 350 people per day. Provided free medical consultations for COVID-19-related symptoms, helping individuals receive professional advice and appropriate care without financial barriers. Free Clinic often provided information on preventive measures, such as hand hygiene, mask-wearing, and social distancing. Educating the public on these practices contributed to overall community safety.

Covid- Free Food Distribution



While we were doing this Oxygen services to the people, additionally we helped the roadside people by providing the food. We distributed the food for **45 days**. Many roadside individuals faced challenges in obtaining balanced and nutritious meals. Food distribution services often included a variety of food items, helping to meet basic nutritional needs and maintain health during the crisis. People living on the streets or in temporary shelters were among the most vulnerable during the pandemic. These individuals often lacked the resources to secure food on their own. Free food distribution targeted this group, addressing their immediate survival needs.

Covid – India's First Free Oxygen (O₂) Auto & Bike Ambulance Service



An auto oxygen ambulance is—a vehicle equipped with medical oxygen supplies and equipment to provide emergency oxygen therapy. We designed the Free Auto & Bike Oxygen ambulance. It was very useful on that pandemic situation. In hospitals, there was no bed and oxygen also. We reached the patient's area where they were located we have given oxygen to the corona patient. Through this, we were established all over Tamilnadu.

FREE OXYGEN (O₂) CONCENTRATOR SERVICE



Our India's first free oxygen (O₂) Auto & Bike ambulance with concentrator service had a significant impact during the COVID-19 pandemic, addressing a critical need for medical oxygen, particularly as hospitals and health systems faced overwhelming demands. We provided essential oxygen support to individuals suffering from severe respiratory distress due to COVID-19. We saved more than 780 lives in Corona

Covid Grocery Kit Distribution



The pandemic led to economic instability, job losses, and reduced incomes, which increased food insecurity for many people. Grocery distribution programs helped bridge the gap by providing essential food and supplies to those who were struggling. We distributed the 200-grocery kit for physically challenged people.

FREE VACCINATION CAMPAIGN (Chennai Corporation)



Initially we started our vaccine awareness campaign in North Chennai.

We have given awareness about the Vaccine and distributed the Phamplets. We Promoted adherence to safety measures such as mask-wearing and social distancing in conjunction with vaccination efforts, helping to protect both vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals.

The Pulicat-Minjur-Pazhaverkadu vaccine awareness campaign aimed to increase knowledge about COVID-19 vaccines among residents in these regions. The campaign focused on educating the community about the benefits of vaccination, addressing vaccine hesitancy, and ensuring high vaccination coverage. Distributed brochures, pamphlets, and posters with clear, accessible information about vaccines, vaccination sites, and the vaccination process. Set up temporary vaccination centres in accessible locations such as community halls and local markets to reach more people.

Chengalpattu – Pallipalayam Vaccine Awareness

The campaign led to an increase in the number of individuals being vaccinated in Chengalpattu and Pallipalayam, contributing to higher overall vaccination coverage.

The campaign helped alleviate pressure on local hospitals and healthcare facilities, reducing the burden on the healthcare system during peak periods of the pandemic.

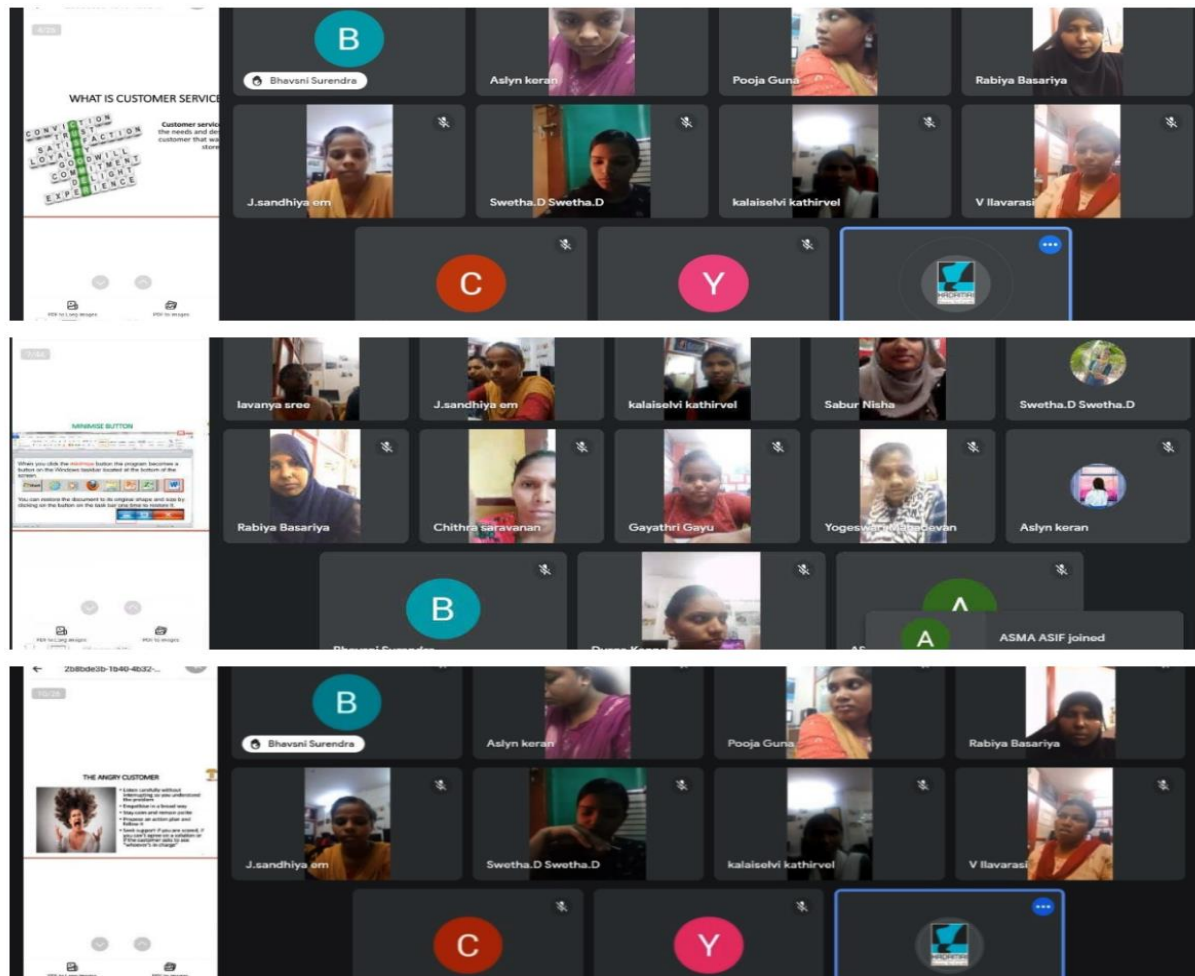

Free Online Computer & Employment Training



During Corona, we didn't stop our Classes. We took the classes through online sessions for our students. We provided a way to continue education and skill development when traditional in-person classes were suspended. After this training, we give placement for the students. This ensured that learners could keep up with their studies and skills development without significant interruptions.
